



Alcohol Policy

Service: We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone at any time. We also reserve the right to curtail, and, cease all together, alcohol service at any time should it become necessary.

Proper Identification: The minimum drinking age in California is 21. To be served or provided an alcoholic beverage, an individual who appears 30 years of age or younger must be able to show proof of minimum drinking age by presenting a government issued photo identification (I.D.). We have the right to, and will, refuse service to any guest who cannot produce proper I.D. Should it become evident to us that alcohol is being provided to under age guests at the party by a guest, we reserve the right to cease alcohol service at an event.

Alcohol Served by Others at the Event: Our staff must be the only persons serving alcohol at the event. Should guests bring their own alcohol we will request them to remove the alcohol from the party, or, if necessary, we reserve the right to immediately stop serving alcohol at the party.

Service of Alcohol to Vendors: It is our policy not to serve alcohol to vendors (i.e. band members, photographers, DJs, etc.), provided that in no event shall Caterer be responsible for the acts of vendors that have acquired alcohol at the party.

Time Frame for Service: Alcohol will be served from cocktail hour until ½ hour prior to end of event. Alcohol will NOT be served prior to the ceremony.

Open & Left Over Alcohol: Once an event is over, we will turn over the leftover alcohol to the person(s) designated (such person must be 21 or older) by the Client. We will not be responsible for the alcohol after it is provided to the designated person.

Alcohol ONLY served by Bartenders: Alcohol is not allowed at rehearsal, prior to the ceremony, as place cards/favors or left on tables (wine bottles placed on dining tables or as table numbers). All alcohol MUST be served by the bartenders only.

No Shots: Consumption of "shots" is not allowed.

Beverage Service: Our bartenders will not serve more than 2 alcoholic drinks per guest per trip to the bar (& less if deemed necessary).

Last Call: Last call for alcohol is 9:30 pm (or ½ hour prior to the end of the event). We will stop serving alcohol at this time. We will not be announcing last call as there will be a sign displayed on the bar to make guests aware of this.

Alternative Transportation: Client is responsible for transportation for any intoxicated person leaving the Casi Cielo Vineyards property; Uber, cab, friend, shuttles. Casi Cielo Vineyards allows cars to remain on the premises in the main parking lot until 10 am the next morning.
